This event gives new drivers the basics of driver safety, track rules and kart maintenance. Learn what to expect on race day, with a review of safety gear, flags and driving rules. Please dress warmly, as it can still be cold at this time of year. Drivers will walk the track and if the weather is good expect to finish the day off driving your kart!

**Rookie School Fees:** \$40 for all drivers. All minors (& parents) must sign the Parental Minor Consent Form at Registration, along with the regular sign in sheets. Pit Passes \$10 for all non-drivers. 12 & under free (non-driver). Must sign in and get a wristband still.

## **Practice:**

New drivers must complete three practices before competing in a race day. Rookie drivers who wish to participate in the opening weekend on April 28th should plan on attending practice on any of the available practice days before then.

## **What to bring:**

Notebook & pen if you want to take notes

Race-ready kart & motor

Driver's suit / abrasion-resistant jacket & jeans\*\*

Full finger gloves\*\*

Full face helmet complying with NKA standards (4.8 Protective Clothing)\*\*

Neck brace and Chest Protector

High top sneakers, boots, or racing boots\*\*

Fuel, oil, & chain oil

Air tank & air gauge

2-cycle or 4-cycle starter, if needed

Catch can for dumping 4-cycle oil

Basic tools – ratchet, sockets (7/16, 1/2, 9/16, 5/8), spark plug, pliers, screw drivers, allen wrenches, hammer, combination wrenches
